#### **Zero Minute Rule:**

**Zero Tolerance:** The "zero tolerance" rules will be followed (i.e.); "Any player who arrives at the chessboard after the start of the session shall lose the game. Thus the default time is zero minutes".

\*\*Please note that only players who take part inthis State Championship will be permitted torepresent Tamil Nadu has selected /special entries in the forth coming National U-11 ChessChampionship for Boys and Girls. HenceParticipation in this State Championship is COMPULSORY.

### **Rules and Regulations:**

**Rules:** FIDE Rules in force shall apply.

**System of Play:** Championship shall be conducted on a 9 Rounds Swiss system.

**Time Control:** 90 minutes each plus 30 seconds increment per move from move no 1.

**Tie-break**: Buchholz tie-break system will be applied. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared.

Age Limit: Players should have been born on or after 1.1.2005

**Age Proof**: Age Proof is required. Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat/Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate. Complaints against suspected overaged players could be made in writing with a fee of Rs 1,000/- before the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> round to the organizers who shall medically verify the players' age. Only the Manager deputed by participating district chess association can lodge such complaints.

**Important note to District Chess Associations:** As per the rules of AICF, only players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their birth are permitted to take part in respective age group nationals. Hence, district associations are hereby directed to forward the names of players whose birth registrations have been done within a year of their births for this TN State U-11 Championship. Wherever discrepancies exist, the matter may be taken up with AICF through TNSCA. This will avoid the inconvenience caused to such players when they appear in National U-11 Championship.

**Note to District Chess Associations:** Kindly advise all your U-11 players to take part in this state Championship.

**Registration of participants with TNSCA is compulsory**. The participants of all TN State Chess Championships are required to register themselves with TNSCA by paying Rs.100/- as registration fee for the year 2016-17. The amount should be remitted along with the duly signed TN players Registration form plus one passport size photograph and Date of Birth Certificate copy.

**Registration of players with AICF:** All the participants must be registered players of All India Chess Federation. Those who are already registered with AICF must produce proof thereof. The AICF registration fee for the year 2016-2017 is Rs.250/-. This amount should be sent by means of **Draft in favour of All India Chess Federation payable at Chennai** along with duly filled and signed AICF Player's registration form with copy of date of birth certificate and one passport size photograph. Entries without AICF registration fee will be rejected. **E-mail id of the player is compulsory.** 

**Lodging:** FREE dormitory type of lodging will be given to seeded /selected players plus one manager (nominated by the concerned district association) per team. Players are requested to bring their own beddings.

Entry Fee Normal: Rs 400/- each. Special: Boys Rs.800/- & Girls: Rs. 700/-.

All entries, be it special or regular, should be routed through the respective District Chess Association before 5 PM on 17.05.2016. Entry fee should be sent by a demand draft in favour of "Namakkal District Chess Foundation "payable at Tiruchengode and sent to Dr.V.S. ## Subject to age limit

#### **Eligibility**:

- (a) Every affiliated member of TNSCA is entitled to send two entries in each category.
- (b) The TNSCA General Secretary can nominate one entry in each category.
- (c) The top four rankers of the last TN State Under-11 Boys and Girls Chess Championships 2015 are seeded to play here in respective category subject to age stipulation, Boys : G. Gnanasabesan (TNV), Bharath Subramaniyam. (CHE) Girls: K.M. Shrija (NLC)
- (d) The top four rankers of the last TN State Under-13 Boys and Girls Chess Championships 2015 are seeded to play here in respective category subject to age stipulation, Boys: Nil, Girls: Nil.
- (d) The top four rankers of the last TN State Under-9 Boys & Girls Chess Championships 2015.

  Boys: D.Gukesh (TLR), Nikhil Magizhnan (TLR), S.Rohit (CHE), P.Dixit Tharun Raja (KGI)

  Girls: M.S Darsana (ERO), . B. Savitha Sri (KAN), V.Harshini (CHE), O.Bhavana (DGL)
- (f) The Winner of the last TN State Under-7 Boys and Girls Chess Championships 2015 are seeded to play here in respective category: Boys: Aswath S (KKI), Girls: Kanishkaa C (MDU).
- (g) The Winner and Runner-up of 2015 TN State Under-11 and under-9 Girls' Championships can opt to play in Boys' section here.
- (h) The host Namakkal District Chess Foundation is entitled to field one additional entry in each category.
- (i) In the event of an odd entry Namakkal District Chess Foundation is entitled to add one more player in each category to take the total number even.
- (j) Any player who has qualified to represent India in World /Asian Chess Championship. Subject to age stipulation
- (k) In addition to the above the following districts can field additional entries by virtue of their players finishing in top four of the 2015 TN State Under-11 Chess Championship: Boys: Chennai: 2 Tirunelveli 1, Madurai 1, Girls: Chennai 1, Dingikul 1, Cuddalore -2.
- (l) Two players in each category approved by TNSCA will be permitted from areas where no district association exists.
- (m) Only Indian nationals are eligible to participate in the Championship
- (n) **Dress code**

Dress Code to be made compulsory for the all the players participating in all the National Championships. To begin with, all the State Associations are directed to give two T-Shirts with their Association logo in the front and the name of the State at the back printed prominently. Players without this will not be permitted to participate.

Note: While Sending the Entries District Chess Associations should certify that the players have been dulyselected from the selection/ District Chess Championship. If such a certificate is not sent, all the entries will betreated as special entries.

A copy of the entry from each district should be sent to TNSCA.

**Canteen** facilities are available on payment basis at the Schools Premises.

Withdrawals: A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

**Appeals Committee:** A five members Appeals Committee will be formed at the Manager's meeting. The decisions of the appeals committee on all protests shall be final and binding.

**Chess Clocks:** Each Association is requested to provide at least one chess clock for every two players.

**Protests:** Protests, if any, against the decision of the arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee Rs.200/- within 30 minutes of the incident. The protest fee is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

**Arrears:** The players belonging to Districts which are in arrears to TNSCA, will not be allowed to take part.

The AICF/TNSCA/ NDCF reserve the right to admit/reject any entry without assigning any reason thereof.

The AICF/TNSCA/NDCF reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place.
