Six trophies each in Under 12 (Players Born on or after 1.1.2005) under - 15 (Players Born on or after 1.1.2002) and under -18 (Plyers Born on or after 1.1.1999) (four for open and 2 for Tiruvallur District Players) will be awarded.

13. Registration of Players with AICF: All the participants of Tamil Nadu State Team Chess Championship must be registered players of All India Chess Federation. Those who are already registered with AICF must produce proof thereof. The AICF player registration fee for the year 2017-2018 is Rs.250/-. While registering, a photo copy of the date of birth certificate (obtained from Municipality/Panchayat, registered within one year of birth) must be produced. Entries without AICF registration will be rejected. Separate E-Mail ID is compulsory for each player registering newly with FIDE and should not be used by any other player.

14. TNSCA player registration fee: All the participants should be registered with TNSCA for the year 2017-18. Those who are not yet registered with TNSCA should register themselves with TNSCA. TNSCA Player Registration fee is Rs.150/- while registering, a photocopy of the date of birth certificate (obtained from Municipality/Panchayat, registered within one year of birth) must be produced. Those have already paid the TNSCA player registration should show the proof at the venue, failing which they have to pay the registration fee.

15. Tiruvallur District Chess Association player registration: Registration is compulsory for Tiruvallur District players. The registration fee Rs.50/- for the year 2017-18.

16. Protests: Protest if any, should be given in writing with a fee of Rs.500/- within 15 minutes of the incident to the Chief Arbiter. All protests shall be decided by the Appeals Committee to be elected at the Captains meeting before the first round.

17. Arrears: The players belonging to District Chess Association / Special Units which are in arrears to TNSCA cannot field their team.

18. Lodging: Free dormitory lodging will be provided at the venue for the participating team & its district representative. All are requested to bring their bedding, etc. Accompanying persons have to make their own arrangements.

19. Rights of Admission: AICF/TNSCA/organizer Tiruvallur District Chess Association have the right to accept/reject any entry without assigning any reason thereof. AICF/ TNSCA/ organizer Tiruvallur District Chess Association reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place. However, their entry fee will be refunded.

20. Interpretation: For Interpretation of the rules and deciding on any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules without prior notice. Such changes will, however be displayed in the tournament hall.

21. Disqualification: Smoking inside the premises is strictly prohibited. No participant shall leave the venue before the prize distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.

22. Instruction to the District Chess Associations: As per the rules of AICF only players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their births are permitted to take part in respective age group Nationals. Hence Dist. Assns are directed hereby to forward the names of players whose birth registrations have been done within a year of their births for this 25th Tamil Nadu State Team Chess Championship-2017. Wherever discrepancies exist, the matter shall be taken up with AICF through TNSCA. This will avoid the inconvenience caused to such players when they appear in Nationals. While sending the Entries, District Chess Associations should certify that the players have been duly selected from the selection/District Chess Championship giving details of venue & Date. If such certificate is not sent the entries will be treated as special entries. While you are sending the entry the following details are compulsory: 1. Team Name 2. Name with Correct Spelling 3. FIDE ID 4. FIDE Rating (If any) 5. Date of Birth Proof 6. Aicf Regn. Number/Proof 7. TNSCA Regn. Number/Proof 8. Valid Email Id 9. Normal or Special Entry 10. Team Captain Name 11. Team Manager

3. Entry fees: Rs. 2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) per team,

can be sent by D.D. in favour of Tiruvallur District Chess Association, payable at Chennai. Entries should be routed through respective district association on or before 18.05.2017 to the following address: S.Balaraman, Hon.Secy, No.24, Janani Complex, 3rd Floor, CTH Road, Thirumullaivoyal, Chennai-62.

Rules & Regulations

4. Eligibility:

- All affiliates of the TNSCA
- Academies/Clubs/Schools/Colleges/Educational institutions affiliated to any of our District Chess Associations; Players cannot participate in the State Team Chess Championship without the written consent of their District Association or Special Unit.
- Each district can send as many as teams possible.

5. System of Play: The tournament shall be a 7 round Swiss. FIDE Rules will be followed.

6. Rate of Play: 90 minutes each with 30 seconds increment from move number 1;

7. Default time: Default time is 15 minutes. Players have to be at their boards within 15 minutes of the start of the rounds.

8. Team composition: Each team will consist of maximum five players and one manager. Each team match will be played on four boards. A team's Fixed Board Order (FBO) for the whole championship shall be given in writing at the Captains' meeting which shall be final. Board order change in any round shall be in ascending order. Fifth board player can play on Board 4, Fourth board player can play only on Fourth or Third board (if any player of the higher board is rested) and so on. Order for each round (Round Team List - RTL) shall be submitted to the Chief Arbiter within the time frame specified at the Captains' meeting. If a team does not submit any board order for any round, only their first four players according to their fixed board order can play in that round.

9. Tie-Break: Pairing will be done by match points. The position of teams that finish with the same number of match points shall be determined by application of the following in sequence, proceeding from (a) to (b) to (c) to the extent required:

- Sonneborn-Berger for Team Tournaments – it is the score (match points) made by each opposing team at the end of the tournament multiplied by the score (game points) made against that team. Then add all these sums together.
- by the sum of the game scores of all the team's opponents;
- Sum of Opponents Match Points (in case of tie, cash prizes will not be shared)

10. Chess Clock: Every team should bring at least 2 Chess Clocks in good working condition.

11. Appeals Committee: An Appeals Committee comprising of three members plus two reserves will be formed at the managers meeting. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such case(s), the reserve member takes his place. The decision of the appeals committee is final and binding on all players concerned.

12. Tournament Committee: The tournament committee consisting of the General Secretary, TNSCA or his representative, The Secretary of Tiruvallur District Chess Association or his representative and representative from another district to be nominated by the TNSCA shall decide on all emergency matters.
