RAPID & RUITZ CHAMPIONSHIPS BILLES & RECHLATIONS

Eligibility: Only Tamil Nadu players are eligible to participate

Registration of participants with TNSCA: All the participants of TN State Open Rapid & Blitz Chess Championships are required to register themselves with TNSCA by paying Rs. 150/- as player registration fee for the year 2019-2020. The players have to submit their Date of Birth Certificate copy and one passport size photo along with the duly signed TN players' Registration Form, Those who have already paid must show the proof thereof.

Registration of Participants with TDCA: Thoothukudi DCA Player registration is compulsory for Thoothukudi District Players only. The registration fee is Rs.100/- for the year 2019-20

System of play: The tournament shall be Played under 9 rounds Swiss system Time Control: Rapid-15 minutes each with 10 seconds increment from move number I

Blitz - 3 minutes each with 2 seconds increment from move number 1

Default time: The "Zero Tolerance" rules will be followed.i.e "Any player who arrives at the chess board after the start of the session shall lose the game," Thus, the default time is zero minute.

Tie-Break: Direct Encounter, Buchholz Cut 1, Sonneborn Berger, Greater Number of wins (forfeit included) tie-break rules will be applied. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared

Appeals Committee: An Appeals Committee comprising of five members plus two reserves will be formed at the managers meeting. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of the committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own districts is involved and in such case(s) the

reserve member takes his place. The decision of the appeals committee shall be final and binding on all players concerned. Tournament Committee: The tournament committee consisting of the General Secretary, TNSCA or his representative, and representative from another district

to be nominated by the TNSCA shall decide on all emergency matters. Right of Admission: The TNSCA/Thoothukudi DCA have the right to accept/

reject any entry without assigning any reason thereof.

The TNSCA / Thoothukudi DCA reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place.

Lodging & Boarding: Free Dormitory type of lodging will be given to all the seeded/selected players along with their parents/Manager. (Separate lodging will be provided to girls & their female parents).

Protest: Protest, if any against the decision of the Chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- within 15 minutes of the incident. The decisions of the appeals committee shall be final and binding on all concerned. The protest fee is refundable on if the protest is upheld.

Withdrawals: A player may withdraw from the tournament at any stage after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

Interpretation: For the rules and deciding on any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules without prior notice. Such changes will, however be displayed in the tournament hall.

Arrears: The players belonging to Districts which are in arrears to TNSCA will not be allowed to take part. Disqualification: Smoking inside the premises is strictly prohibited. No participant

shall leave the venue before the prize distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.

Eligibility:

- Every affiliated district / Special unit can field two players in each category.
- 2. The top four rankers of the TN State Rapid & Blitz Chess Championship 2018 are seeded to respective category.
- 3. In addition to the above the following Districts can field additional entries by virtue of three medal winners (gold, silver and bronze) secured by their players in the last 22" TN State Rapid Chess Championship 2018 held at Tiruvallur. Rapid: Tiruvallur (Gold) - 3, Chennai (Silver) - 2, Kanchipuram (Bronze) - 1
- Blitz: Chennai -3+2+1 (Gold + silver + Bronze) All these nominations from the District Associations shall be given only from the Rank list of their respective District Championships with proof and not to anybody else.
- 4. The host Thoothukudi District Chess Association is entitled to field one additional entry in each category
- 5. Any player who pays the prescribed entry fee of Rs 300/-for Rapid and Rs 150/for Blitz may be considered for participation with recommendation of the respective district Association.
- 6. The TNSCA General Secretary can nominate one entry.
- 7. Any current National Champion in any category is to be seeded to All State championships subject to age stipulation.
- 8. Any current World champion in any category is to be seeded to All state championship subject to age stipulation.
- 9. All GMs, IMs, WGMs & WIMs are seeded to all state championships subject to
- 10. Chess Clocks: Each Association is requested to provide atleast two chess clocks for every four players.
