All entries, be it regular or special, should be routed through the respective district chess association.

** Please note that only the players who take part in this State Championship will be permitted to represent Tamil Nadu as Selected/ Special entries in the forthcoming National U-20 Open & Girls Chess Championship. Hence participation in this State Championship is COMPULSORY.**

**Note to District Chess Associations: Advise all U-20 players to take part in this State Championship. Last date for receipt of entries: 17th December 2021. Strictly Entries will not be accepted after the last date (17th December 2021). All entries be regular / Special should be routed through respective District Chess Association.

COVID-19 - Standard Operating Procedures

All Necessary Precautions and the standard operating procedures with respect to COVID-19 must be followed strictly. Wearing Mask is compulsory, hands must be sanitized, and social distance has to be maintained

Age Eligibility: Those born on or after 01.01.2002 are eligible to participate. Age proof is required. Certificate should be from the Panchayat/Municipality or corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without the date of birth certificate will not be allowed to participate. **As per the rules of AICF, only players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their birth are permitted to take part in respective age group State/ Nationals.** Other country passport holders shall not be allowed to participate in the State Chess Championship.

Lodging: Free Dormitory type of Lodging will be provided in the venue to these seeded/ selected players, Boys & Girls Separately, plus one team manager (nominated by the district association). Players are requested to bring their own beddings. All special entries and accompanying persons have to arrange accommodation of their own.

AICF Player Registration: AICF player registration is compulsory for all players. AICF Player Registration fee is Rs.250/- for the year 2021-2022. AICF player registrations will be accepted only through online. Players / Arbiters registration should be done well before the start of event (Tournament). For renewing AICF registration of existing players, please click <http://aicf.in/players/> and click extend membership For (New) Fresh AICF registration please click <http://aicf.in/online-player-registration/> For fresh AICF registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address (unique) not used by any other person/ player for AICF, ready before the registration process. Note: Only passport size (less than 1MB) photographs in jpeg format should be uploaded.

Default Time: Default time is 15 minutes. Players have to be at the boards within 15 minutes of the start of the round.

Rules: FIDE rules in force shall apply.

System of Play: The Tournament shall be conducted on a Nine rounds Swiss System.

Time Control: Digital Clock 90 minutes each plus 30 seconds increment per move from number one.

Tie-break: Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn Berger, Direct Encounter, number of wins (forfeit included) and greater number of wins by black tie-break rules will be applied. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared.

Chess Clocks: Each Association is requested to provide at least two chess clocks for every four players.

Appeals Committee: An Appeals Committee comprising of five members plus two reserves will be formed at the managers meeting. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such case(s), the reserve member takes his place. The decision of the appeals committee is final and binding on all players concerned.

Tournament Committee: The tournament committee consisting of the General Secretary, TNSCA or his representative, and representative from another district to be nominated by the TNSCA shall decide on all emergency matters.

Protest: Protest, if any against the decision of the Chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.500/- within 15 minutes of the Completion of game. The decisions of the appeals committee shall be final and binding on all concerned. The protest fee is refundable one if the protest is upheld.

Withdrawals: A player may withdraw from the tournament at any stage after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.

Arrears: The players belonging to Districts which are in arrears to TNSCA will not be Allowed to take part.

Rights of Admission: The AICF/TNSCA/organizer Salem District Chess Association reserve the right to admit / reject any entry without assigning any reason thereof. The AICF/TNSCA/organizer Salem District Chess Association reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place. Allowed to take part.

Age Limit: Complaints against suspected over-aged players could be made with a fee of Rs.1000/- to the organizers before the end of the second round who shall Medically verify the players concerned. Only the Manager deputed by Participating district chess association can lodge such complaints.

Instruction to the District Chess Associations: As per the rules of AICF, only the players whose dates of birth are registered Within one Year of their birth are permitted to take part in respective age group. District Chess Associations are directed hereby to forward the names of players whose Birth registration have been done within a year of their birth for this TN State Under-19 Championship. Wherever discrepancies exist, the matter may be taken up with AICF Through TNSCA. This will avoid the inconvenience caused to such players when they appear in National U-20 Championship

Wrist watches of players: AICF has banned the wrist watches while playing in FIDE Rated events. Players are instructed not to wear wrist watches while playing.

Eligibility: Subject to the age limit, the following players can participate:

1. Only Indian Nationals are eligible to participate.
2. Every affiliated District Chess Association / Special Unit of TNSCA is entitled to field four entries in each category.
3. The TNSCA Secretary can nominate one player in each category.
4. The host Salem District Chess Association is entitled to field one additional entry in each category.
5. Any players who pays the prescribed entry fee: Open: Rs.1000/- may be considered for participation with recommendation of the respective District Association
6. In the event of odd entry, the host Salem DCA is entitled add one more entry to make total number as even.
7. All GMs & IMs are seeded to all Open (boys) State Championships subject to age stipulation. All WGMs & WIMs are seeded to all State Chess Championships, subject to age stipulation.
8. Those who have qualified to represent our country in the FIDE Official championships.
