Players without the date of birth certificate will not be allowed to participate. As per the rule of AICF, only players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their birth are permitted to take part in respective age group State/National. Other country passport holders shall not be allowed to participate in the State Chess Championship. Only Tamil Nadu Players can participate this championship
Boarding & Lodging	Dormitory type of rooms will be provided at school campus to selected/selected players and one manager per team.(nominated by the District Association)Players are requested to bring their own beddings. Free Dormitory for others :For others who want to stay with school Accommodation (Dormitory Hall only,Kindly bring your own beddings) they should send an email to the organizer well in advance with all particulars (Player Name , Contact Number, Accompanying Person Name , Relation , Gender and Age) however this can be arranged on first come first served basis only.Boarding : Rich Vegetarian Food will be provided on Payment Basis with Nominal Cost in the School Campus itself.
Registration of Participants with AICF	All the participants of TN State U-9 Chess Championship are required to register themselves with AICF by paying Rs.250/- as player registration fee for the year 2017 – 2018. The players have to submit their Date of Birth Certificate copy and one passport size photo along with the duly signed AICF players' Registration Form. Those who have already paid the AICF player registration should show the proof at the venue.
Registration of Participants	All the participants of TN State U-9 Chess Championships are required to register themselves with TNCA by paying Rs. 150/- as player registration fee for the year 2017-2018, the players

with TNSCA:	have to submit their Date of Birth Certificate copy and one passport size photo along with the duly signed TN Players' Registration Form. Those have already paid the TNSCA player registration should show the proof at the venue.
SOCA Registration	Sivagangali District player's registration is compulsory for SOCA players. The fee for the year 2017-2018 is Rs.50 (Fifty) /- only.
Default Time	Default time is 15 minutes. Players have to be at the boards within 15 minutes of the start of the round.
Rules:	FIDE rules in force shall apply.
System of Play:	The Tournament shall be conducted on Nine rounds Swiss System.
Time Control:	90 minutes each plus 30 seconds increment from the move one.
Tie-break	Direct encounter, Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn Berger and number of wins (forfeit included) tie-break rules will be applied. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared.
Chess Clocks:	Each Association is requested to provide at least two chess clocks for every four players.
Appeals Committee:	An Appeals Committee comprising of three members plus two reserves will be formed at the managers meeting. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such cases), the reserve member takes his place. The decision of the appeals committee is final and binding on all players concerned.
Tournament Committee:	The tournament committee consisting of the General Secretary, TNCA or his representative, The Secretary of Sivagangali DCA or his representative and representative from another district to be nominated by the TNCA shall decide on all emergency matters.
Protest:	Protest, if any against the decision of the Chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.500/- within 15 minutes of the incident. The decisions of the appeals committee shall be final and binding on all concerned. The protest fee is refundable one if the protest is upheld.
Withdrawals:	A player may withdraw from the tournament at any stage after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.
Arrears:	The players belonging to districts which are in arrears to TNCA will not be allowed to take part.
Rights of Admission:	The TNCA /organizer Castle Chess Academy/Sivagangali DCA reserve the right to admit / reject any entry without assigning any reason thereof. The TNCA/ organizer Castle Chess Academy/ Sivagangali DCA reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place.
Instruction to the district Chess Associations:	As per the rules of AICF only players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their births are permitted to take part in respective age group Nationals. Hence Dist. Assns are directed hereby to forward the names of players whose birth registrations have been done within a year of their births for this TN State U-9 Championship. Wherever discrepancies exist, the matter may be taken up with AICF through TNCA. This will avoid the inconvenience caused to such players when they appear in Nationals. While sending the Entries, District Chess Associations should certify that the players have been duly selected from the selection/District Chess Championship giving details of venue & Date. If such certificate is not sent the entries will be treated as special entries. While you are sending the entry the following details are compulsory: 1. Name with Correct Spelling 2. FIDE ID 3. FIDE Rating (If any) 4. Date of Birth Proof 5. Aicf Regn. Number/Proof 6. TNCA Regn. Number/Proof 7. Valid Email Id 8. Normal or Special Entry
