3. Eligibility for Participations (Female players only):

- Every affiliated District Chess Association/Special Unit of TNSCA is entitled to field four entries.
- Top four players form 52nd Tamil Nadu State Women Chess Championship 2023 are seeded.
- The top two rankers from TN State Junior (U-19) Girls Chess Championship 2023 held at Trichy are seeded in respectively.
- In addition to above the following Districts can field additional entries by virtue of three medal winners (gold, silver and bronze) secured by their players in the last 52nd Tamil Nadu State Women Chess Championship 2023 held at Tiruvavur. Gold (3) + Silver (2) – Chennai, Bronze (2) – Kanyakumari.
- The host Thoothukudi DCA is entitled to field two additional entries.
- Any player who remits the prescribed special entry fee of Rs.1500/-. All the entries should come through the **Respective District/Affiliated units.**
- The TNSCA General Secretary can nominate one player.
- Any Current National Champion in any category is to be seeded to All State Championships subject to age stipulation.
- All WGMs and WIMs are seeded for Tamil Nadu State Women Chess Championship.
- In the event of odd entry, the host Thoothukudi DCA is entitled add one more entry to make total number as even in each category.
- Those who have qualified to represent the country in official FIDE events.
- Only Indian Nationals are eligible to participate in this championship.

4. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Eligibility	Age proof is required. Certificate should be from the Panchayat/Municipality or corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without the date of birth certificate will not be allowed to participate. As per the rules of AICF, only players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their birth are permitted to take part in respective age group state/nationals. Other country passport holders shall not be allowed to participate in the State Chess Championship. Only Tamil Nadu Player Can Participate in this championship
Boarding & Lodging	Unfurnished dormitory type of lodging will be provided to seeded/selected players and one manager per team at college campus (Nominated by the district association). Players are requested to bring their own beddings. Canteen facilities are available on payment basis at the college premises itself. All special entries and accompanying persons have to arrange accommodation of their own.
AICF Player Registration	AICF player registration is compulsory for all players. AICF Player Registration fee is Rs.300/- for the year 2024-2025. AICF player registrations will be accepted only through online. Players / Arbiters registration should be done well before the start of event (Championship). For renewing AICF registration of existing players, please click http://aicf.in/players/, and click extend membership. For (New) Fresh AICF registration please click http://aicf.in/online-player-registration/

All entries whether 'regular' or 'special' should be routed through the respective district chess association on or before 20-04-2024. No entry will be entertained after 20-04-2024.

Entry fee can be paid by a cheque/demand draft in favour of "Thoothukudi district chess association" payable at Tuticorin

	For fresh AICF registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address(unique) not used by any other person/ player for AICF, ready before the registration process. Note: Only passport size (less than 1 MB) photographs in jpeg format should be uploaded.
TNSCA Player Registration	TNSCA player registration is compulsory for all players. TNSCA player registration fee is Rs.150/- for the year 2024 – 2025. Players registering with TNSCA should submit duly filled and signed TNSCA Players Registration form along with a copy of their Date of Birth certificate and one passport size photograph.
Thoothukudi District Player Registration	Thoothukudi DCA Registration fee is Rs.75/- for the year 2024 – 2025 (for Thoothukudi district players only)
Default time:	Default time is 15 minutes. Players have to be at the boards within 15 minutes of the start round.
Rules	FIDE rules in force shall apply.
System of Play	The Tournament shall be conducted on a Nine rounds Swiss System.
Time Control	90 minutes each plus 30 seconds increment from the move one.
Tie-break	Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn Berger, Direct Encounter, number of wins (forfeit included) and greater number of wins by black tie-break rules will be applied. In case of tie, prizes will not be shared.
Chess Clocks	Each Association is requested to provide at least two chess clocks for every four players.
Appeals Committee	An Appeals Committee comprising of five members plus two reserves will be formed at the managers meeting. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of committee can vote on dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such case(s), the reserve member takes his place. The decision of the appeals committee is final and binding on all players concerned.
Tournament Committee	The tournament committee consisting of the General Secretary, TNSCA or his representative, The Secretary of Thoothukudi DCA or his representative and representative from another district to be nominated by the TNSCA shall decide on all emergency matters.
Protest	Protest, if any against the decision of the Chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- within 15 minutes of the complication of the game. The decisions of the appeals committee shall be final and binding on all concerned. The protest fee is refundable one if the protest is upheld.
Withdrawals	A player may withdraw from the tournament at any stage after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.
Arrears	The players belonging to Districts which are in arrears to TNSCA will not be allowed to take part.
Rights of Admission	The TNSCA/organizer Thoothukudi District Chess Association reserve the rights of admission to the venue and lodging place.
Instruction to the District Chess Associations	While Sending the Entries District Chess Associations should certify that the players have been duly selected from the selection / District Chess Championship giving details of venue and date. If such a certificate is not sent all their entries will be treated as special entries.
	Players belonging to organization directly affiliated to the AICF will have to give in writing that they will play for Tamil Nadu in the National Women Chess Championship, if they qualify. Those who do not give this in writing before the start of the Championship will not be selected for the National Women Chess Championship, even if they qualify.

A Brief History of the College
