Kamaraj College has been recognised as a Premier Institution of higher learning for students in the southern districts of Tamilnadu. All entries whether 'regular' or 'special' should be routed through the respective district chess association on or before 14-01-2025. No entry will be entertained after 14-01-2025. Entry fee have to be paid only through signinchess.com/chessfee.com/easypaychess.com

Entry fee can be paid by a cheque/demand draft in favour of "Thoothukudi district chess association" payable at Tuticorin

3. Eligibility for Participations (Female players only):

- 1. Every affiliated district/Special unit can field four players in each category.
- 2. The top four rankers of the 53rdTN State Women Chess Championship 2024 are seeded
- The top two rankers of the TN State Junior (U-19) Girls Chess Championships 2024 held at Hosur July are seeded to play in their respective categories.
- 4. The TNSCA General Secretary can nominate one entry.
- The Host Thoothukudi DCA is entitled to field two additional entries. In the event of odd entry, the host Thoothukudi DCA is entitled to add one more entry to make total number as even.
- In addition to above the following districts can field additional entries by virtue of three medal winners (gold, silver and bronze) secured by their players in the last 53rd TN State women's Chess Championship 2024 held at Thoothukudi.
- Girls: Gold (3) Chennai, Silver (2)- Chennai & Bronze (1) Madurai
- Any player who pays the prescribed special entry fee Rs.1500/- may be considered for
 participation and these entries should be duly recommended by their concerned district
 chess association.
- Any current national champion in any category is to be seeded to all State championship subject to age stipulation
- 9. All WGMs& WIMs are eligible to play as seeded player in eligible category, subject to age
- Those who have qualified to represent the country in official Fide events Only. Indians Nationals are eligible to participate.

4. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Eligibility	Age proof is required. Certificate should be from the Panchayat/Municipality or corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without the date of birth certificate will not be allowed to participate. As per the rules of AICF, only players whose dates of birth are registered within one year of their birth are permitted to take part in respective age group state/nationals. Other country passport holders shall not be allowed to participate in the State Chess Championship. Only Tamil Nadu Player Can Participate in this championship Female Players Only
Boarding & Lodging	Unfurnished dormitory type of lodging will be provided to seeded/selected players and one manager per team at college campus (Nominated by the district association). Players are requested to bring their own beddings. Canteen facilities are available on payment basis at the college premises itself. Kindly note that accompanying persons of same gender alone will be permitted to stay together. A boy cannot stay with a female and a girl cannot stay with a male in the college premises.
