

RULES AND REGULATIONS





- Time Control: 90 Minutes plus 30 seconds increment from move 1 for the entire game.
- Tie Break: The following tie break rules will be applicable for all the FIDE Rated Swiss Events under AICF
 - i. Buchholz Cut 1
 - ii. Buchholz
 - iii. Sonneborn-Berger
 - iv. Direct encounter
 - v. The greater number of wins including forfeits
 - vi. Number of wins with Black piecesIncase of tie, cash prize will not be shared.
- As per AICF regulations, wrist watches and other electronic devices are strictly prohibited inside the playing area. AICF has banned the wrist watches while playing in FIDE Rated events. Players are instructed not to wear wrist watches while playing. It will lead to loss of the game.
- AICF player registration is compulsory for all players. AICF Player Registration fee is Rs.300/- for the year 2025 2026. AICF player registrations will be accepted only through online. Players / Arbiters registration should be done well before the start of event (Championship). For renewing AICF registration of existing players, please click https://prs.aicf.in/players and click extend membership. For (New) Fresh AICF registration please click http://aicf.in/online-player-registration For fresh AICF registration, players are requested to keep their scanned passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address(unique) not used by any other person/ player for AICF, ready before the registration process. Note: Only passport size (less than 1 MB) photographs in jpeg format should be uploaded.
- TNSCA player registration is compulsory for all Tamil Nadu players. TNSCA Player Registration fee is Rs.150/for the year 25-26. Players / Arbiters registration should be done well before the start of event (Tournament).

 New entrants to the field of chess are informed that TNSCA players registration is mandatory and it should be
 done well before participating in any tournament. For renewing TNSCA player registration of existing players,
 please click https://registration.tamilchess.com For fresh TNSCA registration please click https://registration.

 tamilchess.com/new-register/ For fresh TNSCA registration, players are requested to keep their scanned
 passport size photograph and birth certificate and a valid email address ready before the registration process.

 Note: Only passport size (less than 1 MB) photographs in jpeg format should be uploaded
- CDCA Registration/Renewal for the year 2025-2026 is mandatory for all Chennai District Players
- Default time is 15 minutes. Players have to be at the boards within 15 minutes from the start of the round.
- Protest, if any against the decision of the Chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs-1000/-within 15 minutes of the incident. The decisions of the appeals committee shall be final and binding on all concerned. The protest fee is a refundable one if the protest is upheld.
- Withdrawals A player may withdraw at any stage of the event, after informing the Chief Arbiter in writing.
- Appeals Committee Before the commencement of the Tournament, appeals committee comprising of five members plus two reserves will be formed from the senior participants present at the players meeting. The appeals committee decision will be final and binding on all the players concerned.

Strict silence must be observed in the Tournament Hall. Players who have finished their games shall not remain in the tournament hall. Players shall not analyse the game in the tournament hall.
